Protest against Boris Johnson, Mayor of London

Boris Johnson is responsible for raising fares, shutting ticket offices, and sacking Tube staff. The out-of-touch mayor once described the £250,000 per year income he got for his *Daily Telegraph* column as “chicken feed”.

No wonder he is so out-of-touch! No wonder he has done little to tackle London’s appalling housing shortage, or rising inequality – even in Barnet, 1 in 5 children now lives in poverty.

Johnson poses as a maverick, fighting for London. In fact he is a leading member of the Conservative Party whose government is cutting and privatising our public services.
