The Conservatives promised that privatisation would save money. But Barnet has paid £59 million to Capita when the cost of providing the same services in house was only £53 million.

The Conservatives won control of the Council by just one seat and a minority of the popular vote. That is not a mandate to continue with the destruction of services, but they intend to:

- **ut the wages of Your Choice Barnet care workers by up to 9.5%**
- cut the funding of nursery schools by up to 50% this year
- close more libraries and outsource children's centres
- privatise schools services that make a profit for the council
- push council tenants out of Barnet, replacing their estates with expensive properties for private owners
- continue to demand council tax from people who cannot afford it
